"But Noah found arace in the eyes of the Lord." Genesis 6:8

What is grace? The American Heritage Dictionary defines grace as "a favor rendered by one who need not do so". Merriam-Webster defines it as "unmerited divine assistance given did; according humans for their regeneration or sanctification". How did Noah find to all that grace in God's sight? Take time to read Genesis 6:5-7

Noah was saved by faith. "By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith." Hebrews 11:7 Noah had to believe God was telling the truth. Noah had never seen a flood. This verse also says Noah was saved by preparing and ark. "...prepared an ark to the saving of his house;..."

Peter tells us that Noah and his family were saved by water. "Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water." **1Peter 3:20**

Water cleansed the world of wickedness. "And, behold, I, even I, do bring a flood of waters upon the earth, to destroy all flesh, wherein is the breath of life, from under heaven; and every thing that is in the earth shall die." Genesis 6:17

The water bore up the ark to rise high above the earth. "And the flood was forty days upon the earth; and the waters increased, and bare up the ark, and it was lift up above the earth." Genesis 7:17

So, what saved Noah, God's grace, Noah's faith, Noah's works, the flood waters? Which of these could he have done without? God's grace was the only way he knew the flood was coming. Noah's faith in God made him listen and obey God's plan. Noah's works built the ark. The flood separated Noah and his family from the old world of sin. All of these were necessary for the saving of Noah and his house. God could have built the ark and put Noah and his family into it, but He didn't.

What of us today? How are we saved?

Paul told the Ephesian brethren "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it

Do not marvel at this, for an hour is coming when all who are in the tombs will hear his voice and come out, those who have done good to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil to the resurrection of judgment.

These verses should give us all pause. The time will come when each of us will leave this life. Though our body will decay and return to the dust, we will be raised form the grave to face our creator. Notice the verse says "all" not just believers, not just the good, but ALL.

There is no one who will remain in the grave, but all will rise to give answer for their life. Death will not keep us from judgment. Each one who lived will answer for their deeds.

In 1Corinthians he says God saves those that believe. "For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe." **1Corinthians 1:21**

The Hebrew writer speaks of the necessity of faith also. "But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him." **Hebrews 11:6**

James says we are justified by faith made perfect by works. "Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect? And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God. Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only." James 2:22-24

The inspired apostle Peter says salvation is by baptism. "The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:" **1Peter 3:21**

As with Noah in the days of the flood, God's grace has provided a means of salvation. But to be saved we must believe God. We must work the works that He has commanded. Hearing and believing are but the beginning of salvation. As Noah, we must do all that God commands. "Thus did Noah; according to all that God commanded him, so did he." Genesis 6:22

We must repent **Acts 17:30**. We must believe and confess **Romans 10:9-10**. We must believe and be baptized **Mark 16:16**
