It should be obvious that God cares how we worship Him.

John 4:24 *God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth.*

Matthew 15:8-9 *“This people honors me with their lips, but their heart is far from me; in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men.”*

But there are many today who think it does not matter how we worship God as long as we are sincere. In keeping with this mindset, if people want jazz, country, hip-hop, or another style of music in worship services, that is all right. If they want solos, quartets, or choirs, that is alright too. If they want mechanical instruments of music in the worship of the church, or even, a group that mimics instruments in the worship, they think that is okay also. If they desire a drama presentation instead of a sermon, they have it. But and this is very important, worship is not entertainment! It is not designed to please people; it is designed to please God!

Psalms 89:7 *"God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be had in reverence of all them that are about Him."*

Think on these things.

(Our studies in the O.T. have given many examples of God's displeasure regarding the worship ideas of men. When the Israelites followed after the practices of the nations they were supposed to destroy, God punished them severely. When Jeroboam instructed the Northern Kingdom to worship at his new altars in Bethel and Dan, God sent a prophet to tell him his false worship practices would cost him his life and kingdom. When kings of the Northern and Southern kingdoms worshipped at high places and groves, God brought famine, drought, and destroying armies. Both kingdoms were sent into captivity, the North never to return, because of their false worship practices. They failed to follow the simple instructions God had delivered through Moses on the Mount. Instead they put their trust in men and human devotions and God punished them. He will do the same today. DLH)
