Proverbs 15:3 The eyes of the Lord are in every place, beholding the evil and the good.

Psalms 139:1-12

Hebrews 4:12-13 For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart. And no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

WOULD YOU BE EMBARRASSED IF

Someone knew what you think about?

Philippians 4:8 Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things.

Command ruling what is watched, read, listened to

Matthew 15:17-19 Do you not see that whatever goes into the mouth passes into the stomach and is expelled? But what comes out of the mouth proceeds from the heart, and this defiles a person. For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false witness, slander.

Sins are first in the heart

Others knew what you said about them?

James 1:19 Know this, my beloved brothers: let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger;

1Peter 2:1 So put away all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander.

About what goes on in your home?

Ephesians 6:1-2 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. "Honor your father and mother" (this is the first commandment with a promise),

Children-what is your attitude toward your parents?

Do you throw fits, talk back and act disrespectful?

Ephesians 6:4 Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

Fathers- Are you a tyrant? Dictator?

Or do you care about the others in your family & leading them in the ways of righteousness?

Or do you want to have everything your way?

Authority given is not to make things "my" way-- not to be abusing.

Ephesians 5:22 Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord.

Wives-would you be embarrassed if someone knew what your attitude was toward your husband and your attitude toward submission?

This says "as unto the Lord". Do you count the Lord as nothing?

Ephesians 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her,

Husbands- are to love wives even as Christ loved the church.

This means you want what's best for them. That you are willing to sacrifice so that others can have needs and wants before yourself, showing that you really do love them.

Would you be embarrassed if others knew what you spent your money on or what you do with your time when no one else was around?

Would you be embarrassed for others to know that you avoided doing things with your family?

Would you, as Christ, be willing to sacrifice? Starting today?

Ephesians 5:33 However, let each one of you love his wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband.

Husbands- Do you love your wife as yourself?

Not purposely hurting others?

Wives- Do you "look up" to your husband?
