We Need To Take Time To Cleanse Self

Many folks are getting ready (or already finished) to do "Spring Cleaning"
Maybe we should consider a Spiritual Cleaning as well
Paul's admonition to the Corinthians applies to us today
Or maybe James' instruction fits better here - **James 4:8**

Cleansing Is Individual

Person is individually responsible - **Ezekiel 18:20; Romans 14:12**
The question is not:

Am I physically strong? Intellectually brilliant? Popular among men?
The question is; Am I faithful to God?

Clean According To God's Standard

Cannot be by standards and doctrines of men - **Isaiah 55:8-9**
It is foolish to trust our own feelings - **Proverbs 14:12**

Can't compare ourselves with others (Might be spiritual weaklings) - **2Corinthians 10:12**
Gods' word is the standard - **John 12:48; 1Corinthians 11:1**

Cleaning Must Be Thorough

Whether you are in the faith must be proven - **Psalms 139:23-24; Ecclesiastes 12:14**
Should seek to improve and grow stronger Lord day by day - **Hebrews 6:1**
Solomon concluded man is never truly happy til he serves God faithfully
Must be thorough enough to look at both strong & weak points
We must make our good points better while eliminating all the bad points

Cleaning Must Be Honest

Hiding stuff in closets or under furniture won't do - **Numbers 32:23**
It is always best to admit our sins and obtain God's and man's forgiveness - **Proverbs 28:13; James 5:16**
Be honest and answer the following questions:
Have I obeyed from the heart the Gospel - **Romans 6:17**
Am I faithfully living as a Christian - **1Corinthians 15:58**
Am I sacrificing for the cause of Christ - **Romans 12:1**

Spring Cleaning Happens Every Year

Notice some scriptures which show this to be so
