A Light In Darkness

Gen 1:1-5

1 In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.

2 The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

3 And God said, Let there be light, and there was light.

4 And God saw that the light was good. And God separated the light from the darkness.

5 God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And there was evening and there was morning, the first day.

Exo 10:21-23

21 Then the Lord said to Moses, Stretch out your hand toward heaven, that there may be darkness over the land of Egypt, a darkness to be felt.

22 So Moses stretched out his hand toward heaven, and there was pitch darkness in all the land of Egypt three days.
 23 They did not see one another, nor did anyone rise from his place for three days, but all the people of Israel had light where they lived.

Exo 13:21 And the Lord went before them by day in a pillar of cloud to lead them along the way, and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, that they might travel by day and by night.

Exo 14:19-20

19 Then the angel of God who was going before the host of Israel moved and went behind them, and the pillar of cloud moved from before them and stood behind them,

20 coming between the host of Egypt and the host of Israel. And there was the cloud and the darkness. And it lit up the night without one coming near the other all night.

Josh 24:7 And when they cried to the Lord, he put darkness between you and the Egyptians and made the sea come upon them and cover them; and your eyes saw what I did in Egypt. And you lived in the wilderness a long time.

Neh 9:12 By a pillar of cloud you led them in the day, and by a pillar of fire in the night to light for them the way in which they should go. **Neh 9:19** you in your great mercies did not forsake them in the wilderness. The pillar of cloud to lead them in the way did not depart from them by day, nor the pillar of fire by night to light for them the way by which they should go.

1Kng 8:12 Then Solomon said, The Lord has said that he would dwell in thick darkness.

Deu 5:22-23

22 These words the Lord spoke to all your assembly at the mountain out of the midst of the fire, the cloud, and the thick darkness, with a loud voice; and he added no more. And he wrote them on two tablets of stone and gave them to me.

23 And as soon as you heard the voice out of the midst of the darkness, while the mountain was burning with fire, you came near to me, all the heads of your tribes, and your elders.

1Sam 2:9 He will guard the feet of his faithful ones, but the wicked shall be cut off in darkness, for not by might shall a man prevail.
Psa 82:5 They have neither knowledge nor understanding, they walk about in darkness; all the foundations of the earth are shaken.
Psa 88:12 Are your wonders known in the darkness, or your righteousness in the land of forgetfulness?
Psa 107:14 He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, and burst their bonds apart.
Psa 112:4 Light dawns in the darkness for the upright; he is gracious, merciful, and righteous.

Num 8:2 Speak to Aaron and say to him, When you set up the lamps, the seven lamps shall give light in front of the lampstand.

2Sam 22:29 For you are my lamp, O Lord, and my God lightens my darkness.

Psa 139:12 even the darkness is not dark to you; the night is bright as the day, for darkness is as light with you. **Psa 56:13** For you have delivered my soul from death, yes, my feet from falling, that I may walk before God in the light of life. **Psa 43:3** Send out your light and your truth; let them lead me; let them bring me to your holy hill and to your dwelling!

2Sam 23:3-4

3 The God of Israel has spoken; the Rock of Israel has said to me: When one rules justly over men, ruling in the fear of God,
4 he dawns on them like the morning light, like the sun shining forth on a cloudless morning, like rain that makes grass to sprout from the earth.

Psa 18:28 For it is you who light my lamp; the Lord my God lightens my darkness.

Psa 27:1 The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

Psa 36:9 For with you is the fountain of life; in your light do we see light.

Psa 37:6 He will bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday.

Prov 2:13 who forsake the paths of uprightness to walk in the ways of darkness,

Mt 6:22-23

22 The eye is the lamp of the body. So, if your eye is healthy, your whole body will be full of light,

23 but if your eye is bad, your whole body will be full of darkness. If then the light in you is darkness, how great is the darkness! Ecc 2:13-14

13 Then I saw that there is more gain in wisdom than in folly, as there is more gain in light than in darkness.

14 The wise person has his eyes in his head, but the fool walks in darkness. And yet I perceived that the same event happens to all of them. **Pro 4:19** The way of the wicked is like deep darkness; they do not know over what they stumble.

Pro 4:18 But the path of the righteous is like the light of dawn, which shines brighter and brighter until full day.

Ecc 11:7 Light is sweet, and it is pleasant for the eyes to see the sun.

Pro 6:23 For the commandment is a lamp and the teaching a light, and the reproofs of discipline are the way of life,

Pro 13:9 The light of the righteous rejoices, but the lamp of the wicked will be put out.

Psa 118:27 The Lord is God, and he has made his light to shine upon us.

Psa 119:105 Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

Psa **119:130** The unfolding of your words gives light; it imparts understanding to the simple.

Isa 42:16 And I will lead the blind in a way that they do not know, in paths that they have not known I will guide them. I will turn the darkness before them into light, the rough places into level ground. These are the things I do, and I do not forsake them.

Isa 60:2 For behold, darkness shall cover the earth, and thick darkness the peoples; but the Lord will arise upon you, and his glory will be seen upon you.

Isa 2:5 O house of Jacob, come, let us walk in the light of the Lord.

Isa 9:2 The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them has light shined.

Isa 10:17 The light of Israel will become a fire, and his Holy One a flame, and it will burn and devour his thorns and briers in one day.

Isa 58:10 if you pour yourself out for the hungry and satisfy the desire of the afflicted, then shall your light rise in the darkness and your gloom be as the noonday.

Isa 26:19 Your dead shall live; their bodies shall rise. You who dwell in the dust, awake and sing for joy! For your dew is a dew of light, and the earth will give birth to the dead.

Isa 30:26 Moreover, the light of the moon will be as the light of the sun, and the light of the sun will be sevenfold, as the light of seven days, in the day when the Lord binds up the brokenness of his people, and heals the wounds inflicted by his blow.

Isa 42:6 I am the Lord; I have called you in righteousness; I will take you by the hand and keep you; I will give you as a covenant for the people, a light for the nations,

Isa 51:4 Give attention to me, my people, and give ear to me, my nation; for a law will go out from me, and I will set my justice for a light to the peoples.

Dan 2:22 he reveals deep and hidden things; he knows what is in the darkness, and the light dwells with him.

Acts 26:23 that the Christ must suffer and that, by being the first to rise from the dead, he would proclaim light both to our people and to the Gentiles.

Isa 58:8 Then shall your light break forth like the dawn, and your healing shall spring up speedily; your righteousness shall go before you; the glory of the Lord shall be your rear guard.

Isa 60:1 Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you.

Isa 60:3 And nations shall come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your rising.

Isa 60:20 Your sun shall no more go down, nor your moon withdraw itself; for the Lord will be your everlasting light, and your days of mourning shall be ended.

Hab 3:4 His brightness was like the light; rays flashed from his hand; and there he veiled his power.

Jhn 1:7-9

He came as a witness, to bear witness about the light, that all might believe through him.

8 He was not the light, but came to bear witness about the light.

9 The true light, which enlightens everyone, was coming into the world.

Jhn 1:4-5

4 In him was life, and the life was the light of men.

5 The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

Jhn 3:19-21

19 And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their deeds were evil.

20 For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed.

21 But whoever does what is true comes to the light, so that it may be clearly seen that his deeds have been carried out in God.

Jhn 8:12 Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.

Jhn 9:5 As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.

Jhn 12:35 So Jesus said to them, The light is among you for a little while longer. Walk while you have the light, lest darkness overtake you. The one who walks in the darkness does not know where he is going.

Jhn 12:36 While you have the light, believe in the light, that you may become sons of light.

Jhn 11:9-10

9 Jesus answered, Are there not twelve hours in the day? If anyone walks in the day, he does not stumble, because he sees the light of this world.

10 But if anyone walks in the night, he stumbles, because the light is not in him.

Jhn 12:46 I have come into the world as light, so that whoever believes in me may not remain in darkness.

Mt 4:16 the people dwelling in darkness have seen a great light, and for those dwelling in the region and shadow of death, on them a light has dawned.

Mt 10:27 What I tell you in the dark, say in the light, and what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops.

Mk **4:22** For nothing is hidden except to be made manifest; nor is anything secret except to come to light.

Lk 8:16 No one after lighting a lamp covers it with a jar or puts it under a bed, but puts it on a stand, so that those who enter may see the light.

Col 1:13 He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son,

Eph 5:8 for at one time you were darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light

Lk **2:32** a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and for glory to your people Israel.

Lk **11:35** *Therefore be careful lest the light in you be darkness.*

Eph 5:11 Take no part in the unfruitful works of darkness, but instead expose them.

Eph 6:12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.

1Thes 5:4-5

4 But you are not in darkness, brothers, for that day to surprise you like a thief.

5 For you are all children of light, children of the day. We are not of the night or of the darkness.

1Pet 2:9 But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.

Acts 26:13-18

13 At midday, O king, I saw on the way a light from heaven, brighter than the sun, that shone around me and those who journeyed with me. **14** And when we had all fallen to the ground, I heard a voice saying to me in the Hebrew language, Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me? It is hard for you to kick against the goads.

15 And I said, Who are you, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom you are persecuting.

16 But rise and stand upon your feet, for I have appeared to you for this purpose, to appoint you as a servant and witness to the things in which you have seen me and to those in which I will appear to you,

17 delivering you from your people and from the Gentiles—to whom I am sending you

18 to open their eyes, so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me.

Acts 13:47 For so the Lord has commanded us, saying, I have made you a light for the Gentiles, that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth.

Rom 2:19 and if you are sure that you yourself are a guide to the blind, a light to those who are in darkness,

Rom 13:12 The night is far gone; the day is at hand. So then let us cast off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light. **2Cor 4:6** For God, who said, Let light shine out of darkness, has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

Eph 3:9 and to bring to light for everyone what is the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in God who created all things,

1Jhn 1:5 This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

Eph 5:13-14

13 But when anything is exposed by the light, it becomes visible,

14 for anything that becomes visible is light. Therefore it says, Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you. **2Tim 1:10** and which now has been manifested through the appearing of our Savior Christ Jesus, who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel,

1Jhn 1:6-7

6 If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.

7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. **1Jhn 2:9-11**

9 Whoever says he is in the light and hates his brother is still in darkness.

10 Whoever loves his brother abides in the light, and in him there is no cause for stumbling.

11 But whoever hates his brother is in the darkness and walks in the darkness, and does not know where he is going, because the darkness has blinded his eyes.

Mt 5:14-16

14 You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden.

15 Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house.

16 In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.

Rev 21:23-24

23 And the city has no need of sun or moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gives it light, and its lamp is the Lamb.

24 By its light will the nations walk, and the kings of the earth will bring their glory into it,

Rev 22:5 And night will be no more. They will need no light of lamp or sun, for the Lord God will be their light, and they will reign forever and ever.

1Cor 4:5 Therefore do not pronounce judgement before the time, before the Lord comes, who will bring to light the things now hidden in darkness and will disclose the purposes of the heart. Then each one will receive his commendation from God.
