Not in man to direct his own steps - Jeremiah 10:23 Man must have someone to turn to or to go to - Matthew 26:41

Should We Go To Moses?

Moses prophesied of a new prophet - Deuteronomy 18:15 Law (given by Moses) last only till Christ came Galatians 3:19-26 Law was nailed to the cross - Colossians 2:14 Some sought to be justified by the law as some today Galatians 5:1-4

Should We Go To John The Baptizer

John to prepare way for one greater than he - Luke 1:17; John 1:23 John dead when Jesus promised build his church - Matthew 14:10; 16:18 John was beheaded around AD 30

Christ promise to build church was around AD 32 John was never even in the church - Matthew 11:11 John's baptism was not sufficient - Acts 19:1-5

Should We Go To The Preacher Or Any Man?

Might assist in understanding but cannot save souls - 1Corinthians 11:1 Denominationalism result blindly following men - 1Corinthians 1:10-13 Some of Paul, Cephas, Apollos, Christ Were these men crucified for us -- no -- only Christ Only one perfect example - 1Peter 2:21

Should We Go To The Church (Body)?

Some say the church is the originator of truth

Some give church more authority than Scripture - 1Timothy 3:15 Become part church result of obeying truth - Romans 6:16-18; Acts 2:47 Church does not save, it is the saved - John 8:31-32

We Should Go To Jesus The Christ (Why)?

God has spoken through His Son - Hebrews 1:1-2; Luke 9:34-35 Christ has all power (all authority) - Matthew 28:18 Individuals heard word (Jesus) turned to Lord - Acts 11:14,19,21,23 Christ is man's only Saviour - Matthew 1:21; Hebrews 5:8-9; John 6:68-69; John 14:6
