This passage must be understood if we are to believe and obey God

Nicodemus did not understand this statement John 3:4

Definitions

Except - on any other condition than that; unless; qualification follows

Born - brought forth by or as if by birth; New beginning (Spiritual)

Again - another time: once more: anew

ASV/RSV: Anew - in a new manner or way (Clearer description)

Cannot - can not Unable to; No right to, no permission to

See - to perceive by the eye; to perceive or detect as if by sight; to have experience of; to come to know

Enter into - to go or come in; to come or gain admission into a group -- often used with into; to begin to consider a subject -- usually used with into or upon; to go upon land for the purpose of taking possession; to play a part: be a factor

Kingdom - a politically organized community or major territorial unit having a monarchical form of government headed by a king or queen; often capitalized - the eternal kingship of God; the realm in which God's will is fulfilled; a realm or region in which something is dominant; an area or sphere in which one holds a preeminent position

Of - relating to; in respect to; indicates belonging or a possessive relationship

Restatement Of Verses Using Definitions

Unless a man is brought forth in a new manner, he has no right to experience the realm that belongs to God. **John 3:3** DLH Unless a man is brought into existence by the way of water and the Spirit he is unable to gain admission to the realm which belongs to God **John 3:5** DLH
