Gods Chain Of Salvation 2Corinthains 5:17-21

From the time of Adam's sin God had plan whereby man could be returned to the state from whence he had fallen.

This plan was to reconcile or to put man in a position where he would be friends with God again - to change the enmity to friendship.

This plan was made necessary by the disobedience of man

The problem was not with God but with man - Isaiah 59:1-2

The plan was for man to be reconciled to God not God to man

Author - God (v.18)

All things are of God

God is the source or author of the plan to restore man to a position of friendship to Himself. -Matthew 25:34; Ephesians 1:4

Although it was man's sin that necessitated this plan of reconciliation it was God who initiated it Only by his plan can this be accomplished - Matthew 7:21

Agent - Christ (v.18)

God designated his son Reconciling the world in Christ (v.19) Reconciled by the death of his son - Romans 5:10

Ambassadors - Apostles v.18,19 (All Christians)

Given to us the ministry of reconciliation Committed unto us the word of reconciliation We are ambassadors for Christ v.20 Apostles to teach others to teach - Matthew 28:19-20 Commit to faithful men who shall be able to teach others - 2Timothy 2:2

Archive - Written Word (v.19)

Word of God - John 1:1,14 Only way we can know of reconciliation Christ the word made flesh Word - Christ – Truth - John 1:14 Apostles guided into all truth - John 16:13 Could not have reconciliation without the Word Word able to save souls - James 1:21

Availability - To The World (v.19)

Would do no good if God planned it, made his Son the agent, selected ambassadors who recorded the plan, But failed to place it within reach of all mankind Made available to all men - 1Timothy 2:3-4
Substance of reconciliation is found in v.19
Not imputing (counting) their trespasses unto them
God through Christ's death overlooks sin
Sins are covered by Christ's blood
Blood reached through baptism - Romans 6:3-4
Reconciliation is in the body - the church which Christ built - Ephesians 2:16; Matthew 16:18; Colossians 1:18
Church doesn't reconcile but reconciliation is in church - the body
Obedient faith appropriates benefits of Christ's death - Romans 6:3-4
And sets one in the church
Baptism saves Mark 16:16; 1Peter 3:21
Adds saved to the church Acts 2:47

Baptized into Christ put on Christ Galatians 3:27

Baptized into one body 1Corinthians 12:13

Reconciled in Christ v.19 - So we conclude that anything that puts one in Christ (His body) also brings about his reconciliation to God

Advantages - Made Righteousness Of God (v.21)

Made Him to be sin for us "FOR" indicates substitution Christ died as a substitute for us - **1Peter 3:18** He suffered all that we should have suffered We might be made the righteousness of God in Him (v.21) Justified - innocent before God Made friends with God again Look forward to living with God forever.

Plan for reconciliation is provided for everyone *2Peter 3:9*

We cannot become friends again with God by our own power or arrangement - only by his plan Have you been reconciled to God thru the blood of Christ?
