Methods

Planned Lessons - Class books, Correspondence lessons Subject or Topic Concordance, Topical Bible Consider all passages on topic Must be careful to remember context Book or Exegesis - Detailed study of entire book or passage Book study useful - keeps context in mind Originally presented as 'books' Works well with daily reading program also Overall view with daily reading + detailed view of intensive passage study Similar to advice from Pawpaw - "Read like a novel from cover to cover then go back & study each section in depth" Assists 5 Ws - Who speaking to Whom; What addressed; When spoken; Where found; Why spoken Regularity Praver Study Helps Translations - (N)KJV, (N)ASB, ESV, NIV & NEB (easy to read, but not precise) Avoid one man/denomination versions (Living Bible, New World) Thompson Chain Reference (KJ,NAS,NKJ,NIV) - good reference system Dickson (KJV - out of print) **Dictionary - Regular & Bible** Davis, Easton's Vine's - Greek & English Concordance - Young's; Strong's; Cruden's; Nave's Topical Bible Encyclopedia - Information on people, places, and things in Bible Zondervan's; International Standard; Halley's Bible Handbook **Bible Atlas** Commentaries - Not inspired, but learned men Old Periodicals/Articles Many of these are available in electronic form as part of Bible study programs/apps Mainly need a Bible Grandfather - Vine's, Young's, Nave's, Johnson's & a Dickson Study Bible Exercise care with men's writings. Remember context; Be consistent - 2Timothy 2:15
