Hebrews 5:8-10

We ought to be children of obedience.

Disobedience leads to eternal damnation

Understanding how we can disobey can help us keep from it so that we may remain pleasing to God

Consider five categories of disobedience

Commission – Doing What Is Forbidden

Restrictions in Eden – *Genesis 2-3*

Romans 8:13; Romans 1:28-32; 1John 3:4

Omission - Failure To Do What Has Been Commanded

Jonah 1:1-3; Matthew 25:41-46; Ephesians 6:11,13

Procrastination is the thief of time. Important that we preach

Acts 22:16; Hebrews 2:1-3; 2Peter 3:18; James 4:4

Addition - To Do More Than God's Command

Not in teaching only but practices as well

Revelation 22:18; Galatians 1:6-8; 1Corinthians 4:6

Instruments, Creeds, Names, Organization

2Timothy 3:16-17; Acts 20:32

Substitution - Replace God's Command

Leviticus 10:1-2; 1Samuel 15:22; Romans 6:4

Subtraction - Take Away From God's Command

Revelation 22:19; Luke 11:42

Some leave off Lord's Supper, Laying By (giving), attendance at services

All these are displeasing in the sight of God.
