Damage of one insignificant; many destroy - Exodus 10:1-20

Story of old man who gave a bundle of sticks to sons and said break them. Each one failed, when he untied the bundle the sons broke the sticks easily - moral of the story, you must stick together - **1 Corinthians 3:9** 

Paul planted Apollos watered-Cooperation God gave increase

A lack of oneness - Philippians 3:16; Philippians 1:27 Members of physical body directed by one spirit

Likewise spiritual body directed by one spirit

Two contrasted dispositions

Self depreciation

Underestimate value; feel inferior - 1Corinthians 12:15-16

Ability differs but each held responsible - Matthew 25:14-30

Depreciation of other Christians - 1Corinthians 12:21; Philippians 2:3-8

A self-willed spirit

Some want to have their own way or else

We must be tolerant

We must be willing to follow leadership

When asked to do something, then give it the best that you have
