Implies ownership (Potiphar bought Joseph) - 1Corinthians 6:19-20

By redemption - Ephesians 1:7

Involves Faithfulness - 1Corinthians 4:2

Obedience, follow instruction - Deuteronomy 10:12-13; 11:26-28; Matthew 7:21-23

God's claim is above all other obligations - Matthew 10:37-39; Acts 4:18-20

God Owns Our Bodies

We are to glorify God in body - 1Corinthians 6:19-20

Body -- instrument of righteousness - Romans 6:12-13

Paul - not brought under power of other things - 1Corinthians 6:12

Gave themselves to the Lord - 2Corinthians 8:5

Not for our own pleasure without owner's consideration
