Stewardship

A steward is a trusted servant to whom the master has delegated responsibility in helping to promote his affairs

Resources

They belong to God - 1Chronicles 29:14; Psalms 24:1; 1Timothy 6:6-7

We must use our resources wisely - Lk 12:16-20 (rich farmer)

Providing for our families - 1Timothy 5:8

Giving to Lord on 1st day of the week - 1Corinthians 16:1-2

Cheerful, bountiful, liberal giving - 2Corinthians 9:6-7; 8:1-5

What should we return? - Mark 12:41-44; Acts 4:32-37

What was required of Jews? - Hebrews 7:4; Genesis 28:20-22; Leviticus 27:30-33

Giving to those in need - Matthew 25:37-40

Sharing food and clothing with the needy

Garden produce? Closet cleaning?

Contributing to community services - Luke 6:37-38; Acts 20:35; 1Timothy 6:18

Labor so we will have to give the needy - Ephesians 4:28

Showing hospitality - Romans 12:13

Inviting others into our home

Driving folks to doctor or store

Our resources can be misused

Trusting in wealth - Psalms 49:5-12; 1Timothy 6:17

Grudgingly using wealth with others - 1Peter 4:9; 2Corinthians 9:7

Love of money - 1Timothy 6:9-10

Squandering our resources - Luke 12:16-21; Matthew 25:27

Buying what we do not need

Buying what we cannot pay for or puts us under financial strain

Buying to help others when we cannot meet own obligations

We are accountable to God for our resources

Be content with whatever you have - 1Timothy 6:8

Do not let care for them choke out the Word - Mark 4:18-19

Remember they are temporary - 1Timothy 6:7

Be rich toward God; for eternal benefit - 1Timothy 6:18-19

They make it harder to go to heaven - Matthew 19:23-24
