Associates it with lust

Man's Questions

Can innocent remarry? Can guilty remarry?

Can a put away spouse later mentally put away a spouse that commits adultery after a divorce?

Can one repent of an adulterous relationship & remain in that relationship?

Would desertion or abuse free one to remarry?

Does an unbeliever's marital situation matter?

What Does The Word Say? - **Matthew 19:3-12; Mark 10:2-12; 1Corinthians 7:1-40**

Divorce Involves Adultery/Sin!

Matthew 5:31-32; Luke 16:18; Matthew 19:3-12; Mark 10:2-12

Divorce Can Be Avoided!

We can choose to feed our relationship or feed our discontent. - **1Corinthians 7:1-9**

We allow it to happen - **1Corinthians 7:10-17**

God Has Never Liked Divorce!

Why is it allowed in one exceptional case?

Adultery, fornication, sexual immorality is very personal and hard to overcome.

When we worship another we disgust God! - **James 4:4**

Same with marital adultery, the injured party is disgusted!

Thus God allows divorce for such wicked behavior.
