Should Honor Mother

Only two people in history without a mother Adam & Eve Would not exist without her Jochebed - Moses Who we are because of her love Bathsheba - Solomon Eunice - Timothy Not all serve as mothers or wives Qualities that make a good Mother also seen in one who is a true servant of God

Martha gets a bad reputation

Often focus on her failing Like Abraham's lying or David's infidelity Consider her highs instead of her low Not a mother, but an example of a woman who served the Lord

Hospitable

At least 1 guest (Jesus) Possibly more than a dozen - John 12:1–2

Industrious

Busy in preparation - Luke 10:38-42

Believer

"I know ..." - Confession of Christ - John 11:17-27

Faithful

Probably of the women who provided for Jesus & disciples - Luke 8:1-3

Focused

Martha seemed concerned about properly serving the Son of God with food & hospitality Distracted - Anxious, Troubled - Matthew 6:25–34; Philippians 4:4–7

Jesus reminds her that giving attention to His Word is more important - even for believers and supporters - Luke 8:4–8; Mark 4:1–9,21–25
