What Is Sin?

Iniquity - gross injustice; wickedness; a wicked act or thing; sin; Lawlessness or working without law; Turning from the straight path - Isaiah 59:2; Matthew 7:23

Transgression - infringement or violation of a law, command, or duty; To step beyond or across (Webster); Going beyond that which is written - 1John 3:4

The word sin - Used in Greek sports when an arrow fell short; Hamartano: Literally to miss the mark; Hamartia: offence, sinful - Romans 3:23

What Are Some Attitudes Toward Sin?

Some say all things from God; God doesn't sin so there is no sin -2Timothy 3:16; 1John 1:8 Some contend that the child of God cannot sin - 1John 2:1-2

Sin now fix it later - Galatians 6:7; Ecclesiastes 12:1

It doesn't matter if you do sin, just don't mention it and it won't matter - Galatians 6:1

What Is The Nature Of Sin?

Sin Is Rampant Everywhere - 1Peter 5:8; 1Corinthians 9:27

Covers all aspects of life - 1John 2:16; Genesis 3:6; Matthew 4:1-11; James 1:13-15

Sin does not come out in the open and say "I am sin!" - Matthew 7:15; Revelation 3:17

What Are The Results Of Sin?

Isaiah 59:1-2; James 1:15; Romans 6:23; Hebrews 11:25; 12:1

All Have Sinned

Romans 3:23: 1John 1:8
