Saints

Hagios - Sacred (physically pure, morally blameless or religious, ceremonially consecrated): (most) holy (one, thing), saint. - Strong's

One separated from the world and consecrated to God; one holy by profession and by covenant; a believer in Christ - Easton's Bible Dictionary

The word "saint" is derived from a Greek verb (hagiazo) whose basic meaning is "to set apart," "sanctify," or "make holy." - Baker's Evangelical Dictionary of Biblical Theology

Without saints there is no church! - The purpose of its organization is to prepare the saints - Ephesians 4:11-12
