Worthy

In continuing our first Sunday look at Worship, expand on point we have made in defining the idea
Worship comes from Worth-ship

We honor and magnify God in our worship as He is most worthy - **Psalm 29:1-3**

Many Psalms are focused on giving praise to our God.

At least 10 start with "Allelujah" ("Praise the Lord" in english)

Psalm 148 is the basis for our song, "Hallelujah, Praise Jehovah!"

We praise that we see as having great value.

Certainly, God is worthy of praise - **Revelation 4:11; 5:9-10**

Our thoughts today are prompted by an article on **Psalm 145** by Weldon Warnock I ran across in
looking at material I had on worship.

This Psalm of David is evidently an acrostic poem or hymn in the original Hebrew

From beginning to end it provides to us a means of praise to our great and wonderful Creator

Praise God

Praise His Name - Psalm 145:1-2

In line with our approach in prayer - **Matthew 6:9**

No matter our reason for reaching out to God, we begin with giving honor to who He is: our
Creator, Master, Savior

Praise His Greatness - Psalm 145:3-7

His power and majesty are obvious in His Creation - **Romans 1:20; Psalm 139:14**

Genesis 1 provides the account of His creating all we can know in 6 days. His mighty works of
discipline and salvation fill the pages of that book.

The Gospels declare the power of Deity through Jesus as he healed, expelled, raised, and then died
and was raised for His creatures.

Truly we praise with "How Great Thou Art!"

Praise His Graciousness - Psalm 145:8-16

Demonstrated most vividly in life and death of Jesus - **Philippians 2:5-8**

He provides for all - **Matthew 5:45**

Calls all to return that they might be prepared for judgement - **Acts 17:30-31; 1Peter 2:9**

Has provided a kingdom where we can enjoy even greater blessings into eternity - **Colossians 1:13-14**

In this relationship we are raised from the depths of despair and given hope for now and forever. -

Titus 2:11-14; 1Peter 1:3-5

Let us Praise Him for His Gracious Goodness

Praise His Righteousness - Psalm 145:17-20

As shown in the life of Jesus as well as Abraham, David, Daniel, Esther, etc. God provides a way to
Him and ALWAYS keeps His promise. - **James 4:8**

He draws us close and helps us move ever nearer to Him as we walk through this life.

He will protect, help, & reward according to what He has Spoken. He will also punish and destroy
those who ignore & turn away from His commands.

Justice & Righteousness are synonymous with God.

He is Righteous

Praise God - Psalm 145:21

Our worship should be filled with praise to the God who created us.

We should praise Him every day as well.

He is Worthy - Praise God!
