Return to Gospel of the Kingdom - Matthew 4:23 Still same sermon Counter wrong attitudes regarding others Not all will follow the teachings in the same manner Our attitude toward them must reflect earlier instructions - mercy & love Must remember own failings and faults and the struggle I encountered in learning to overcome these - John 7:24

Judgment Is Required

Must determine "hogs & dogs" - Matthew 7:6,15; 1John 4:1; 2John 9-11 Can one determine whether one is weak in the faith? - Romans 14:1; 1Corinthians 11:13; Colossians 2:16 How we make judgments matters Must make righteous judgments

Righteous Judgment Demands:

Righteous standard - John 12:48; Matthew 15:1–9; Colossians 2:13-17; 2Corinthians 5:7 Righteous motive - Matthew 6:2-6; Philippians 1:15-17; 1Corinthians 13:1-3 Judgment directed at individual - John 1:46; Acts 10:34-35; 16:20; 1Corinthians 5:12-13 Regarding standard not abusive - 1Corinthians 11:20,31-32 Judgment with mercy - Micah 6:8; Matthew 5:7; 2Corinthians 2:6-8 Consistent application to ourselves - John 7:22-24; Matthew 7:3-5; Romans 2:1-3,21-23
