Read it daily so it will remain fresh in your mind as you go about your business

Read it slowly so you can think through what each passage is teaching

Read it in small sections so you can get the message intended by each writer

Read it topically, read it chronologically, read it as a series of separate writings on a common theme Read it with Prayer!

Pray before you read. Pray after you read. Pray while you read.

Pray for understanding. Pray for wisdom. Pray for knowledge.

Read it aloud. Read it alone. Read it together. Read it in silence.

Read it when you are overwhelmed to find peace

Read it when you are confused to see the way

Read it when you are in sorrow & grief to find hope

Read it when you are down or depressed to find joy

The best plan for reading the Bible

- 1. Set aside a time to read the Bible
- 2. Read the Bible during that time.
