2Kings 5:20-27

Ignoring Law Has Consequences

There are consequences for our action - **Genesis 8:22**

This is what Paul references in Galatians - **Galatians 6:7-9**

"For every action there is an equal and opposite reaction"

Try ignoring gravity ...

Thrown forward when hit brakes hard, pushed back at quick acceleration

Parenting Has Consequences

Lot - Captive, lost children, evil of daughters, descendants destroyed by Israel

Isaac & Rebekah - Favoritism - rivalry among sons

Eli - **1Samuel 2; 1Samuel 3:13-14**

David - Wicked, immoral sons; divided kingdom

Emotions Have Consequences

Anger, hatred - **Matthew 5:22,25**

Immorality Has Consequences

Adultery - Destroyed lives, broken homes, fatherless, motherless - **Proverbs 1:8-9; 11:14**

Immodesty in dress and action - **Genesis 38:15**

Drugs, Alcohol, Tobacco - Often long-term health issues

Sin Has Consequences

Brings about rebuke - **Numbers 32:23; Titus 1:12-13; Ephesians 5:11**

The first sin - **Genesis 3:16-20**

Enmity between woman's seed and seed of serpent **15**; Sorrow and pain in conception **16**; Ground cursed **17-19**; Shame **21** - Function of conscience. **8-10**

Separated from Tree of life - **Genesis 3:22-24**

Some remain despite being forgiven

Weeds, work, pain - **Romans 1:18-27; Genesis 19:12-13**

Sickness, sorrow - **Romans 13:3-4; 1Peter 2:20**

Death - **Genesis 2:17; Isaiah 59:1-2; Ephesians 2:1-3; 1Corinthians 15:22**

Wrath of God - **Ephesians 5:6; Romans 2:5**

Eternal consequences - **Romans 6:23; Hebrews 2:2-3; Matthew 7:13-14; 2Thessalonians 1:7-9**
