Satan's Craftiness

Beware of the craftiness of Satan. The wiles of the devil are many, and we must stand against them (**Ephesians 6:11**). The whole armor of God is the only effectual means that we have to overcome the deceit that the evil one uses against us. Even in the midst of religious activity, Satan casts his seeds of doubt to undermine the faith of the unwary and the easily deceived ones. He comes sometimes through "learned" professors and "theologians" from religious schools and universities to tell the world that "the faith" of the Word of God (**Jude 3**) is actually a composite of legends, traditions, and symbols borrowed from Roman paganism. These "professors" tell the world that facts of historical events, authorship of the Scriptures, and even the true identity of characters in the Bible may have no basis in reality.

By casting doubt upon the authenticity of the Scriptures, the devil tries to undermine the whole structure of the faith by destroying its foundation. In truth, no human history has the credentials of the Scriptures. No human history has been scrutinized and validated over and over as the Scriptures have. One of Satan's devices is the equating of human tradition and Scripture so that, by showing the fallacies of some human traditions, he may try to make the Scriptures appear to be false. Those who give good and diligent heed to the Scriptures are, by their knowledge of the Word of God, able to recognize and distinguish human tradition and to see their errors. The Scriptures warn of apostasy, and it has occurred many times, but truth remains true (**Hebrews 3:12; 2Thessalonians 2:3-4; 1Timothy 4:1-7**). Simply reading the Scriptures thoughtfully surely will impress the reader with the wisdom, goodness, and harmony of the Word of God. Faith comes by hearing the Word of God (**Romans 10:17**), and faith is sustained and strengthened by the Word of God (**Colossians 1:9-12; 1John 2:14**).

Search the Scriptures. See what the Bible actually teaches. Strengthen and solidify your faith by the knowledge of the Word of God. Learn by careful study how to handle aright the Word of Truth. Feed upon the milk and meat of the Word, and it will bring health to your soul.

(Placing doubt about the Word of God in the mind of men has been used by the evil one since the beginning of time. It will be his way to deceive until the end of time. Too many do not believe in God simply because they have not read and considered His Word due to this simple deception. DLH)
