Is There A Resurrection?

The Gospel Preached To Corinth **1Corinthians 15:1-11**

Christ died, was buried, was raised as promised

Resurrection evidenced by those who saw Him

If not Christ was not raised

Then Preaching Is Vain v14-15

False testimony

Resurrection is central to the Word we believe - **Romans 4:24-25**

Peter's theme on Pentecost was the risen Savior - **Acts 2:32**

God's power is shown by the resurrection of Jesus - **Romans 1:4**

Faith Is Vain v14

Faith worthless - **Acts 1:2; Romans 10:17**

Without a resurrected Christ our faith is in false testimony

To lie of resurrection taints all teaching as lies - **2Timothy 1:8-12**

Still In Sin v17

Hebrews 7:25

While shed blood in death paid for sins, reconciliation depends upon resurrection - **Romans 5:6-11**

Dead are perished v18

Revelation 14:13; 1Corinthians 15:19

Hallelujah, Christ Arose! v20

Acts 17:31; 1John 5:4-5; 1Thessalonians 4:14; 2Corinthians 4:14; Romans 6:1-11

Resurrection Is Foundation
