A Lesson On Patience

James 5:11; 2Peter 1:6

Patience defined

NASB – endurance; NKJV – perseverance; ASV, KJV – patience

Greek - hypomone hoop-on-on-ay' - cheerful (or hopeful) endurance, constancy:--enduring, patience, patient continuance (waiting).

Webster - the capacity, habit, or fact of bearing pains or trials calmly or without complaint; manifesting forbearance under provocation or strain; not hasty or impetuous; steadfast despite opposition, difficulty, or adversity; able or willing to bear

Importance of Patience - **1Corinthians 15:58; James 1:2-8; 2Timothy 3:12**

Job's Patience Was Tried...

Notice the source of Job's trials - **Job 1:6; 1Peter 5:8-9; James 1:12-15**

Riches though not mentioned in list of trials - **Luke 8:14**

Such trials may lead one to destruction - **Luke 12:13-21**

Loss of all property - **Job 1:13-17; 2Corinthians 8:2**

We are made stronger by such trials if we do not fail - **James 1:2-4**

Death of his children - **Job 1:19; Hebrews 9:27**

Suffered personal afflictions - **Job 2:3-8; 1Peter 1:6-7**

This may lead to a crown, or it may lead to death - **James 1:12-15**

His loved ones, his wife and then his friends - **Job 2:9; Matthew 5:11; Matthew 10:34-39**

Job was steadfast in all this - **Job 1:20-22**

Yet Job Endured - Job 2:10

The reward will be great for those who so endure - **Matthew 5:12; 1Peter 2:19-21**

Victory In Patience - Job 42:12-17

We can be victorious - **James 1:2-4; James 1:12; 1Peter 3:10-17**
