Jesus our Savior

Known before the world; Seen in future days; Glimpsed by righteous men; Son of God.

John 1:1–18

Sent as David's heir; Named an ageless king; Granted all the earth. Exalted.

Romans 1:3–4; Ephesians 1:19–23

Seen with blinded eyes; Heard by heedless ears; Met with wicked hearts; Son of God.

Isaiah 6:9; Matthew 13:14–15

Worshipped with contempt; Crowned with blood and thorns; Throned upon a cross. Exalted.

Luke 23:11; Mark 15:16–20

Scorned by those who watched; Mocked by all the wise; Loved within belief; Son of God.

Luke 23:32–43

Born to take my death; Slain to give me life; Jesus, Son of God. Exalted. Exalted.
