Kill The Flesh

We Must "Put To Death" Sin Those that appeal to the "lust of the flesh" Sexual immorality Impurity - moral sense: lustful, luxurious, profligate living Passion - depraved passion, vile passions Evil desire - craving, longing, for what is forbidden, lust Also that which appeals to the "lust of the eyes" Covetousness - Greedy desire to have more, avarice Equivalent to idolatry! Puts things in the place of God Covet material objects, mind things below, making idols! Sins of the "emotions" Anger - Violent emotion; brings hurt or harm Wrath - Passionate anger; boiling up, soon subsiding Malice - Malignity, ill-will, desire to injure Sins of the "tongue" Slander - Speak evil of others or God Obscene talk - Foul speaking, low obscene speech Lying - speak deliberate falsehoods; deceive by a lie Must practice what we believe - Colossians 3:8-9 Baptized, "put off" old man & deed - Colossians 2:11-12 Clear out the old can work more on the new

Nourish The New Man In Christ

In baptism we "put on Christ" - Colossians 3:10; Galatians 3:27 Denied self, crucified self, now Christ lives in us! - Colossians 2:6-7; Galatians 2:20 Also "risen with Christ" - Colossians 2:12; Romans 6:4 Practice principle so that "Christ is All and in All" - Romans 8:29 Become like Christ, destroying barriers divide man! - 2Peter 1:5-7 This changes ... How we treat others Heart of Compassion – benevolence, compassion, pity – tender mercy Kindness--Benignity, kindness Our State of mind/attitude - Philippians 2:5-8 Humility – Humble opinion of self; a deep sense of moral littleness; modesty, lowliness of mind Meekness--Gentleness, mildness How I act when mistreated Longsuffering--Patience, slowness in avenging Forbearing--To sustain, to bear, to endure, bearing with one another Forgiving one another--to do something pleasant or agreeable (to one), to do a favor to, gratify; to grant forgiveness, to pardon" Forgiving others demanded, we are forgiven by Christ!

Held together by Love
Greek agape--meaning good will, benevolence
"binds everything together in perfect harmony" all virtues together (like a belt)
W/out love, no other virtues last; w/it, others maintained
Together, These Display "Character of Christ"
