Seeking God

Reaching out and wanting a closer relationship with God - Matthew 6:33

Song (589) uses terms that apply to both Father & Son

May wrestle with which, but actually fits both - Psalm 107:9

The song expresses the desire to make God/Christ the most important aspect of our lives.

Panting For God

Verse 1 - As the deer pants for the water so my soul longs after You. You alone are my heart's desire and I long to worship You.

Drawn from symbolism of the Psalmist - Psalm 42:1-11

In temptation, distress, grief, sorrow we long for God/Christ

The Life-giver refreshes our spirit - John 4:10-15; 7:37-39

Like water to a dry land - Psalm 63:1-8

Gathering for worship (in the sanctuary) brings us closer to God/Lord - Psalm 29:1-2; 1Kings 8:27-30

True Blessing

Verse 2 - I want You more than gold or silver, only You can satisfy. You alone are the real joygiver, and the apple of my eye.

Matthew 5:6

God/Lord provides true riches and sustenance - Psalm 119:72; Isaiah 55:1-5; James 1:16-18
Since God/Christ brings us true peace and joy through the Word they should be our most favored companion in life - Philippians 4:4-10

Seek The King

Extra Verse - You're my friend and You are my brother Even though You are a King. I love You more than any other, So much more than anything.

He is our friend - John 15:12-17

As such He seeks our well-being - Matthew 11:28-30

Know Him as King

Important to teach Kingship, reminds Who determines our way - Philippians 2:9-11; Acts 2:32-36

God Alone Satisfies

Chorus - You alone are my strength, my shield; to You alone may my spirit yield. You alone are my heart's desire and I long to worship You.

Philippians 3:7-10

In the end it is important to draw near to our King/Creator - Revelation 21:5-8

We must love God/Christ above all else - Mark 12:29-30
